

Steps for Drawing a Room in Perspective


Supplies: 9"x12" Drawing paper, pencil, eraser, ruler




4. Back Wall-Complete your square by drawing your last horizontal line




4. Back Wall-Erase the X in the interior or inside the back wall. Do not erase your vanishing point




5. Door-Draw a vertical line




5. *Door* – Draw a line from the top of the line to the vanishing point





5. Door-Draw a parallel vertical line




5. *Door* – Erase line from edge of door to vanishing point









8. Floor- Draw evenly spaced points where the back wall meets the floor.



8. Floor Tiles- Draw verticle lines to make floor tile. These lines should get farther apart as you get closer to the bottom edge of the paper.



8. Floor-Line up each point with the vanishing point and draw a line. Your ruler will move like the hand of a clock.



8. Wood Floor- Draw horizontal lines between every other vertical line.
